Subject: Watering Horses

Dear Mayra Segovia,
The Animal Welfare Act requires "adequate water sufficient to maintain the animal in a state of good health" be provided, and the Code of Practice for the Care and Handling of Equines requires the following:

-Horses must have access to safe, palatable and clean water in quantities to maintain health and vigour.
-In extreme weather conditions (cold or hot), special attention must be paid to ensure water availability, access and intake.
-Water troughs, containers and any automatic watering devices must be cleaned regularly and maintained in working order with no sharp or abrasive edges.

If the watering system you are proposing can meet these requirements, then there should not be an issue from an animal welfare perspective. Also, I suggest you review the Code of Practice for the Care and Handling of Equines to ensure you are in compliance with its requirements.
