Health and Safety

Health Canada regulates the health and safety of telecommunications antenna installations to ensure the safety of the public.

Health Canada is continuously reviewing health and safety associated with the transmission of radio frequencies.

In 2015 Health Canada updated their Safety Code 6 standards.

Health and Safety

“With respect to cell towers, as long as exposures respect the limits set in Health Canada’s guidelines, there is no scientific reason to consider cell phone towers dangerous to the public.” – Health Canada

“Precautions to limit exposure to RF energy from cell towers are unnecessary because exposure levels are typically well below those specified in health-based exposure standards.”
– Health Canada

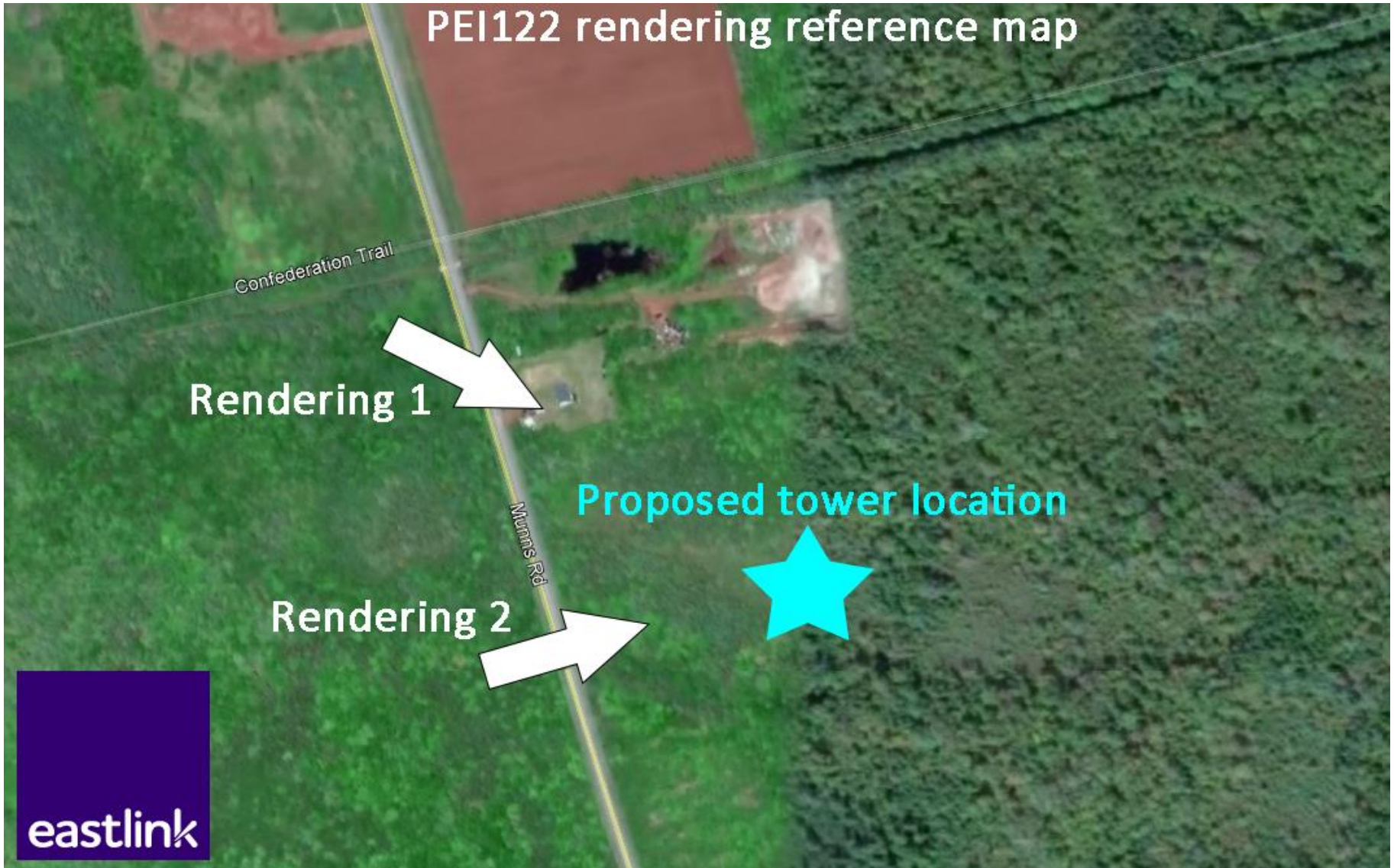
